CSL TRACK RECORD!

202 CSL proposals have been signed into law by the Governor between 1987 and 2016



WHAT SUCCESS LOOKS LIKE

Two Critically Important CSL Bills:

- **SB 128 – The End of Life Options Bill** – the CSL enthusiastically co-sponsored this controversial Bill.
- **AB 643 – Silver Alerts** – This bill mirrors the Amber Alert, putting emphasis on wandering or missing elders



In 2013, I had the pleasure of partnering with ***Tania Wood and Donna Jensen*** on a legislation that requires administrators of residential care facilities with LGBTQ residents to undergo additional sensitivity training. AB 663 (Gomez) signed into law!
